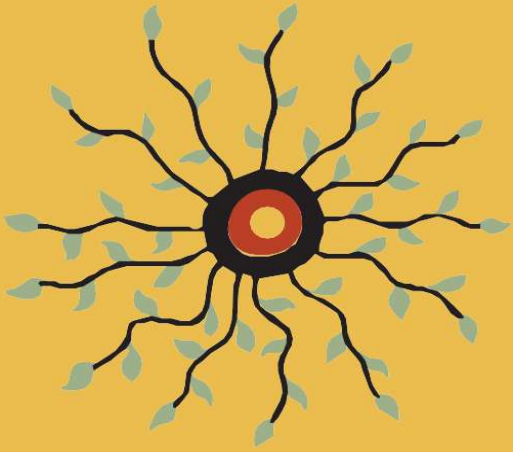

This Expression of Interest (EOI) is to be read in conjunction with the Grant Procedure when applying for funding by way of the grant for business development (BDF) purposes from the Trust.

Business plan development

For eligible beneficiaries, a grant may be provided of up to \$20,000.00 for the payment of Consultants, Business Advisors, Financiers, Accountants, Engineers, or other professional fees for the development of business plans, feasibility studies or supporting documents for a business plan including cash flows, financials and marketing projections.

Business capital injection – Micro $\leq$ \$10,000

For eligible beneficiaries, a grant may be provided of up to \$10,000.00 without the provision of a detailed business plan.

Business capital injection – Large $\geq$ \$10,001

The Trust may grant large capital injections where ongoing benefits have been identified and detailed business plan(s) have been prepared. Any grant greater than \$10,000 is considered a large business grant.

There is no limit on the size of funds for the capital injection requested. Each application is assessed on its merits against the purpose and objectives of this policy. Depending on the level of risk identified by the Trust in the received business plan, the Trust may engage other specialist advisors to aid in the assessment.

In ALL cases – BDF applications to the Trust are referred to Business Foundations Ltd in accordance with the Trust's Procedure.

Please complete all of the information required by this form attaching any documentation providing further information if relevant. The more information you can provide about your business proposal the better, as this will allow Ely to make a better-informed decision about your application. Failure to provide relevant information will result in delays to your application being assessed and could lead to it being rejected.
